First off, you can allow your camera to use all the focus points to determine the best target to lock onto. For on-field action, typically a lens with a focal length of at least mm will be needed.

Some of the most dramatic soccer and hockey photos come from cameras mounted on a tripod. On a bright sunny day, this is usually the best setting to use. By separating the actions of focusing and taking the picture, you will have greater control and independence over both roles. Over time, as your feel for the game from behind the camera improves and as you begin to master these techniques, you will find yourself coming home with more and more keepers!
