In this way we must prove the credible opinions endoxa about these sorts of experiences—ideally, all the credible opinions, but if not all, then most of them, those which are the most important. Ward argues that the examination of homonymy has a central role in Aristotelian dialectic. Of course health, which is Aristotle on Homonymy: Dialectic and Science the core of the notion, is not itself healthy; and on reflection it becomes hard to see that we are dealing here with homonymy, rather than some form of paronymy.
